
CLEANING PROCEDURE | DYCEM® ACCESS TILES

Method 1: Pre-saturated wipes



Clean tiles at least once a day (or as advised by your specialist) to maximise performance.



Clean using a pre-saturated wipe (isopropyl alcohol wipe - 70/30 IPA reccommended).



Apply pressure and wipe over the surface until dirt it removed. Allow to dry.

Method 2: Spray & flat mop



Clean tiles at least once a day (or as advised by your specialist) to maximise performance.



Spray the surface, or the flat mop with a Dycem-approved cleaning solution (diluted per manufacturer's instructions).



Using a flat mop clean the surface, working away from the controlled area. Use a dry flat mop, wipe, or squeegee to pick up the excess liquid if necessary.



Tips & Advice

- For maximum performance, clean your
 Dycem mats at least once a day (or as advised by your specialist) with the following:
 - InSpec N10 or approved cleaner
 - Spray bottle or pre-saturated wipes
 - Flat mop
- After cleaning the Dycem, wash out any equipment so that it is ready to reuse.
- Where decontamination or sterilisation takes place using a phenolic or hydroxide, rinse as per the instructions. Otherwise a film will develop reducing the effectiveness of Dycem.
- For heavily decontaminated areas, contact Dycem's customer service team who will be happy to discuss the best solution with you.
- DO NOT USE concentrated bleaching agents, scouring or abrasive powders, or cleaning machines with stiff brushes. Buffing or polishing machines will damage the surface, shortening the active working life of the Dycem.
- If you would like to **clean mechanically**, please check with your Dycem representative to see if it is compatible.
